

Available Grant:

Ontario's Main Street Relief Grant: PPE Support

Amount: One-time Grant Up to \$1,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- 2 to 9 Employees
- In one of following sectors:
 - retail
 - accommodation and food services
 - repair and maintenance
 - personal and laundry services
 - gyms and yoga studios

Proof:

Receipts or proof of costs for PPE purchased since March 17, 2020.

PPE Includes

- Gloves, gowns, face shields, eye protection, masks, sanitizer, sanitizing wipes
- Thermometers, temperature monitors or cameras
- Physical changes, including the installation of hand sanitizer stations and plexiglass dividers.
- Signs to guide or inform customers and employees.

Available Grant:

Property Tax and Energy Cost Rebate Grant

Amount:

- Rebate for municipal and education property taxes
- Energy costs including electricity and natural gas (or propane and heating oil if natural gas is not available)
- Funding will cover entire length of time restrictions are in place in your region

Eligibility Criteria:

Eligible for Ontario Small Business Support Grant (below)

In addition, businesses are eligible if they:

- are, or were, required to close or significantly restrict services as a result of being under control or lockdown restrictions in the COVID19response framework: keeping Ontario safe and open
- were required to close or significantly restrict services because of being under "modified Stage 2" restrictions in the previous framework.

Proof:

- Property Tax Bills or proof of costs associated with property taxes.
- First Energy Bill (Electricity, Natural Gas, Propane, heating oil or other) you received on or after the day modified Stage 2, control or lockdown restrictions were put in place in your region.

Ontario Small Business Support Grant

Amount:

- One-time Grant of \$10,000 to \$20,000
- Dollar for dollar funding to help cover decreased revenue expected because of Provincewide Shutdown.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Minimum revenue decline of at least 20% comparing monthly revenue in April 2019 to April 2020 • Be required to close or restrict services due to Province Wide Shut down on December 26, 2020
- Fewer than 100 employees
